**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners that the motor vehicles, identified herein and in the attached letter from Brent Teague, Schools Director of Maintenance to Kevin Rogers, Forsyth County Fleet Manager, which is incorporated herein by reference, are hereby declared to be surplus, obsolete, or unused by the County.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners hereby approves the donation by Forsyth County to the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education of the surplus, obsolete, or unused County vehicles identified herein pursuant to the provisions of N.C.G.S. 160A-280.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chairman or the County Manager and Clerk to the Board are hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of Forsyth County, the necessary documents to convey title to the said vehicles by donation to the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education pursuant to the provisions of N.C.G.S. 160A-280, on the conditions that said vehicles shall be used or disposed of and the proceeds thereof used by the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education solely to replace aging vehicles in the school system's active fleet and that the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education shall waive all rights to make any claims against Forsyth County relating to any failure of performance of the said donated vehicles, to which they agree by accepting title to the vehicles, all subject to a pre-audit certificate thereon by the County Chief Financial Officer, if applicable, and approval as to form and legality by the County Attorney.
