**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE AMOUNT TO BE SPENT FOR
REAL PROPERTY FOR CONSTRUCTION AND EXPANSION OF THE

WHEREAS, the provisions of N.C.G.S. 115C-426(f) require the approval of the Board of County Commissioners as to the amount to be spent for school sites prior to the execution of a contract by the Board of Education for the purchase of a site or the expenditure of funds therefor; and

WHEREAS, on April 24, 2018, the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education approved a purchase price of \$52,160.00 for Real Estate owned by Lucy M. Donadio, S. Jane Mccready, H. Ray Dull, Jr., S. Elizabeth Reagan and Rebecca Baird to facilitate the construction and expansion of the new Robinhood Road Middle School Project, which property is further identified as a portion of Tax Block 4613, Lot 002D, PIN 5886-54-9930.00, on the Forsyth County Registry, subject to approval of such purchase amount by the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education requests that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners approve Fifty-Two Thousand One Hundred Sixty and 00/100 Dollars (\$52,160.00) as the amount to be spent for the real property for construction and expansion of the new Robinhood Road Middle School Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners hereby approves the amount of Fifty-Two Thousand One Hundred Sixty and 00/100 Dollars (\$52,160.00) for the purchase of real property owned by Lucy M.
